***A Meditative Walk Through the Mass"***

The Second Vatican Council declared that the Eucharistic Liturgy, the Mass, "is the summit toward which the activity of the Church is directed; at the same time, it is the fountain from which all her power flows."

Our understanding of and engagement in the Mass must always be expanding and deepening. When we become accustomed to a certain way of doing things, we seldom ask *why* we do it that way. But the Mass, as "summit and fountain," is too critical to our Catholic life *not* to stop and ask *why* we do this or that at Mass.

## PRO-LIFE POSTCARD CAMPAIGN

On January 24-25, **you will be asked to sign postcards to your three national legislators that reads as follows:**

"At this time of serious national challenges, Americans should unite to serve the good of all, born and unborn. The Freedom of Choice Act (FOCA), the most radical and divisive pro-abortion bill ever introduced in Congress, would create a "fundamental right" to abortion that government could not limit but would have to support. FOCA would overturn many existing widely-supported policies, including laws protecting parental involvement and conscience rights and those preventing partial-birth abortion and taxpayer funding of abortion and taxpayer funding of abortion. Please oppose FOCA or any similar measure, and retain laws against federal funding and promotion of abortion. As your constituent, I would appreciate a written response telling me how you would vote on these matters."

## STOP, LOOK, AND LISTEN

How long does it take to fall in love?" This is a pointless question, because such huge realities as love and death are part of an eternal life process. They are woven into a huge tapestry that includes both time AND eternity.

Still, there *are* certain moments when God seems to interrupt everyday life to speak to us in a special way. Maybe you narrowly escape a head-on collision; or your child becomes critically ill; or your closest friend or partner dies too soon. It is as if a kaleidoscope has been shaken, and all the pieces of your life have been rearranged into a different picture. If we're listening, God can use these moments to deepen our virtues—to increase our patience, our courage... to expand our wisdom... or to shock some part of us out of dullness and routine, and back into life. Whether we're young or old, God is still calling us, not just into a job or a new career, but to a constant "re-weaving" of the tapestry of our lives.

How is God calling your name these days? It has nothing to do with your age or your experience. I repeat—even if you are raising four kids, or already retired after 30 years on the job—do you realize that God is still calling your name with as much love and enthusiasm and challenge as before you were born? And are you still listening?

Perhaps your call is to be more honest—to quiet yourself—to be more generous, or patient...to believe more passionately... to love without judgment. As we approach the Eucharist today, try saying, "Speak, Lord, your servant is listening." And then really listen this week.

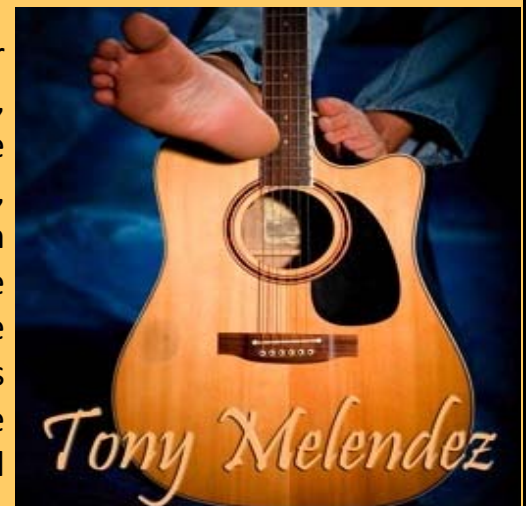

In the Parish Administration Office, 2nd floor.** You will need your Drivers License for signature verification. The fee charged by the FBI for processing the prints is \$36. Currently the processing is taking over 8 weeks to be cleared and returned, so, be sure and plan accordingly as volunteers must be cleared prior to volunteering. The Diocese also has new guidelines for "Safe Environment Training". In order for fingerprints to be cleared, all individuals must view a short film on-line and answer questions regarding providing a safe environment.

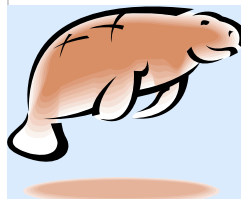
